Casuarina cunninghamiana

Common Name: 'River She Oak''

Landscape value:

An Australian Native, that naturally occurs along many river banks.

It naturally self-mulches and supresses other plants growing underneath in its root zone.

The She-oak is a nitrogen fixing tree and the root system can stabilise loose soil, excellent for erosion control.

As the wind blows through the tree it makes a beautiful whistling noise.

Plant as a feature tree or in group plantings. Most suitable for screening.

Typical size: 12 – 25m x 8 - 15m

Growth rate: Fast

Habit: Pendulous, upright

Foliage: Evergreen green-grey fine pine-like foliage

Flowers: Male and female flowers on separate plants

Position: Full sun part shade

Season of Interest: Summer

Soil Type: Prefers well drained, alkaline, light to heavy soil. Overall tolerant of most soils including waterlogging

Tolerances/cultivation: Frost and drought tolerant,
